A. Eligibility Criteria

1. The Bidder should be a company incorporated in India under The Indian Companies Act, 1956/2013 and subsequent amendments thereto or a Partnership Firm registered under The Indian Partnership Act 1932 or the Limited Liability Partnership Act 2008 or a Sole Proprietorship registered under the applicable Shops and Establishment Act.
2. The bidder should be a registered company with minimum three (3) years existence and working in the same field.
3. The bidder should be a manufacturer or distributor (Authorization from Manufacturer is must if in case of distributor)
4. The bidder should have an annual turnover of minimum Rs. 25 lakhs (Twenty Five lakh rupees) during each of the past three (3) financial years. (CA certified declaration has to be attached) 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24.
5. Joint bids will not be accepted.
6. The bidder should not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State/ Union Territory/Union Government (Self declaration is required)
7. The bidder should have supplied similar kind of goods to one or more Government owned organizations / Public Sector Undertakings or reputed companies in private hospitality sector worth of minimum Twenty Five (25) Lakh per annum in last three years (Prior experience certificate/work order/completion Certificate has to be uploaded)

B. Documents to be uploaded:

The Bidders are required to upload the following documents on the designated e-procurement portal

1. A valid **Certificate of registration** of the Firm issued by the competent authority.

4. Documents in support of **minimum three (3) years' experience** of the bidding Firm in the field of manufacture/distribution of crockery. (Work order, Performance certificate, Work completion certificate).
5. **CA audit reports** in support of annual turnover of minimum Rs. 25 lakhs in each of past three (3) financial years. Mere certificates issued by Chartered Accountants will not be accepted.
6. **Income Tax returns** of the firm for past three (3) years.
7. **Undertaking** by the bidding firm to agree with the Terms and Conditions of the Jungle Lodges & Resorts Limited.
8. **Undertaking** to the effect that Agency is not under a declaration of ineligibility or blacklisted for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by any State/ Union Territory/ Union Government.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Joint bids will not be accepted.
2. The rate quoted for Linen should be inclusive of delivery costs at JLR Godown, Ulsoor, Bengaluru.
3. The quote of individual items shall be taken in considering least bidder.
4. The rates quoted should be valid for a period of Six months (06 months) from the date of Work order / supply order.
5. The tenure of contract is one year and extendable for one year based on the quality of service provided. No change in price shall be entertained during the contract period.
6. The rates quoted should be inclusive of taxes, transportation and JLR branding (logo).
7. The mentioned quantities are indicative and it may be increased/decreased. The orders for actual numbers may be placed in one or more stages within the contract period depending on the actual requirement at a given point of time.

08. Performance Security

Within 21 days of the receipt of notification of award from the Purchaser, the successful Tenderer shall furnish the performance security of **Rs.1,00,000/- in** the form of DD/NEFT or Bank Guarantee valid up to 3 months after completion of contract period.

Failure of the successful Tenderer to comply with the requirement, shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the earnest money deposit, in which event the Purchaser may make the award to the next lowest evaluated Tenderer or call for new tenders.

09. Least bidder will be derived based on the below.

Total Price = Total Estimated Units x Price quoted per product.

10. The Goods supplied under this Contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specifications and when no applicable standard is mentioned, to the authoritative standard appropriate to the Goods' country of origin and such standards shall be the latest issued by the concerned institution.

11. Sample to be sent to the above office address before the technical Bid opening.

12. In the event of any correction of defects or replacement of defective material during the Warranty period, the Warranty for the corrected/replaced material shall be extended to a further period of six months over and above the initial Warranty period.

13. Inspections and Tests:

The Purchaser or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Contract specifications at no extra cost to the Purchaser. SCC and the Technical Specifications shall specify what inspections and tests the Purchaser requires and where they are to be conducted. The Purchaser shall notify the Supplier in writing in a timely manner of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

Should any inspected or tested Goods fail to conform to the specifications, the Purchaser may reject the goods and the Supplier shall either replace the rejected Goods or make alterations necessary to meet specification requirements free of cost to the Purchaser.

14. **Packing:** The Supplier shall provide such packing of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination as indicated in the Contract. The packing shall be sufficient to withstand, without limitation, rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperatures, salt and precipitation during transit and open storage. Any damaged product should be replaced within 15 days.

15. **Warranty:** The Supplier warrants that the Goods supplied under this Contract are new, unused, of the most recent or current models and that they incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the Contract. The Supplier further warrants that all Goods supplied this Contract shall have no defect arising from design, materials or workmanship or from any act or omission of the Supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied Goods in the conditions prevailing in the State. This warranty shall remain valid for 12 months after the Goods or any portion thereof as the case may be, have been delivered to and accepted at the final destination indicated in the Contract,

16. Bidders should bid for all the items mentioned.

17. All disputes will be subject to jurisdiction of courts within Bengaluru city limits.
